What is bullying?

Bullying is when someone is verbally or physically threatened or hurt by another person or group of people over and over again.

- Emotional
- Cyber
- Discrimination (Equality Act 2010)

What do adults and children do to stop bullying?

- We actively teach and promote our school values of respect, compassion, truth and perseverance.
- We follow the school behaviours
 - o Be respectful and polite to adults and children
 - Be kind and helpful to each other
 - Work together to keep school tidy and safe
 - Be truthful
 - Be positive and persevere
- We write class rules and agree to stick to them.
- We follow a debugging process / script.
- We learn about how to respect others and ourselves
- We learn about what bullying is and what we should do if it happens to us.
- We tell a trusted adult if we think we are being bullied.
- All adults look out for bullying and listen to anyone who is worried.
- We have anti bullying lessons / assemblies each term.
- We teach online safety, and have an online safety day each year.
- We tell a trusted adult if we think someone else is being bullied.
- We use appropriate language at all times and especially when referring to someone's race/gender/religion/sexuality/belief or ability.
