

PUPIL PREMIUM GRANT 2014-15

What is it?

Pupil Premium is a grant which is allocated to schools. The Pupil Premium Grant for 2014-15 is allocated to schools with pupils on roll in January 2014 that have been known to have been eligible for free school meals at any time during the last six years. Each of these pupils will attract a specific amount of money each year which must be spent to improve their education. If you think your child is eligible for free school meals please contact the school office for further information.

During 2014-15 the school has been allocated £83,200

The grant is used to support interventions to help narrow the attainment gap between groups and increase the overall attainment across the school.

INTERVENTIONS SUPPORTING DURING 2014-15

Additional Teaching Assistant in Foundation 1 to raise language levels
Part time Nurture Group
Reading Recovery Teacher to support individual children with their reading
Extra Teaching Assistants to support individual children and small groups with their communication, reading and writing skills
Extra teaching hours to support reading, writing and maths with F2 and Year 2 pupils
Teaching Assistant to support children with English as a second language
Educational visits to provide new experiences for children
After School Clubs

The interventions above are monitored using assessment data. The school's use of Target Tracker and the Early Years Foundation Tracker enables staff to easily track each child's progress termly against national expectations.
