

This week in Reception

Phonics:

We will revisit all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs - ai, oa ee, igh, ur, or, er, ar, ow, oi, ear, air and apply them to the writing of words. We will be reading and writing CCVCC words including stamp, twist, trust, crept, stand, crisp, blend, crunch, crust, grand, squelch, string, scrap, splat, strong, scrunch. We will be writing sentences such as : 'I can drink lots of milk.' We will be reading and writing the 'tricky' words: **were, here, little, says.**

Choose a 'tricky' word and write your own sentence using the word: said, so, have, like, some, come, love, do, were, here, little, says, there, when, what, one, out, today.

Eg We like to come to go to
We have some little chicks.

What we are learning:

In Literacy, we will be sharing the wonderful story of 'The very hungry caterpillar' by Eric Carle and focusing on retelling the story using narrative language and ordering the days of the week. We will continue to segment sounds to write words and apply digraphs and trigraphs. We will work on the correct formation of letters and using the pencil grip rhyme. We will be studying the life cycle of a butterfly and ordering the stages.

In Maths, we will be developing our knowledge and understanding of doubles and halves and splitting a number into equal groups. We will be counting backwards from a number and we will be focusing on comparing numbers using the language of 'more,' 'fewer,' 'less,' and 'equal.' We will give reasons and explanations.
