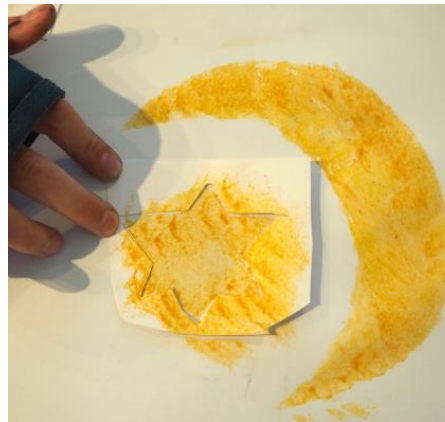


Key Vocabulary

Key Word	Definition
Sketch	A rough drawing an artist makes to note down ideas.
Capture	To describe or show (someone or something) in a very accurate way by using drawing, painting, collage etc.
Composition	The arrangement of various visual elements in an artwork.
Elements	The visual components of colour, form, line, shape, space and texture.
Lighting	The light source or light reflected within the composition.
Focus	The point of interest or activity in a work of art.
Present	To show and talk about you work with others.
Share	To show and discuss your artwork and the process used with others.
Reflect	Think about how successful something is and why.
