## Parents/Carers Home School Agreement

### To help my child at school, I will do my best to:

- see that my child attends school regularly, properly equipped, well-rested and ready to learn;
- ensure that my child is dropped off and collected at the correct time;
- inform the school on the first day of absence;
- raise any concerns or problems that might affect my child's ability to learn or behave appropriately; by talking with the class teacher;
- support the school to make sure my child maintains good behaviour;
- follow the school's E-Safety guidance (see E Safety Agreement)
- support my child with home learning (homework) opportunities;
- listen to my child read and spend time reading to them;
- attend parent/carers consultation evenings or other meetings with the teacher/other staff member, to discuss my child's achievements, next steps and progress;
- support staff in creating a caring, respectful school community by reinforcing the school's values at home and encouraging my child to treat others with kindness and respect.
- work with the school to ensure my child receives any additional support they may need, including following agreed plans and sharing relevant information promptly.
- read all letters, messages, emails that are sent home;
- inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details;
- ensure my child wears school uniform and sensible footwear – this includes appropriate PE kit;
- encourage my child to participate in a range of activities;
- follow the School Communication Policy (the policy is attached)
