

## This week in Reception

### Phonics:

In Phonics, we will be learning to read words ending in 's' such as sports, starts, boasts. We will be learning the 's' ending which sounds like 'z' in words such as crowds, groans, trains. Finally, we will be learning to read and spell words ending in 'es' such as dresses, splashes, screeches. We will say the following sentence 3 times, and count the words. We will segment the sounds in the words and write the sentence using cursive letter formation: 'The frog hops in the pond.' We will continue spelling 'tricky' words.

### What we are learning:

This week we will be sharing a favourite story 'The train ride' and visualising what we might see from a train window. We will be using adjectives to describe scenes and creating our own window scenes using a variety of resources such as pastel, crayons, paint. We will write descriptive sentences taking care over the correct spellings of 'tricky' words

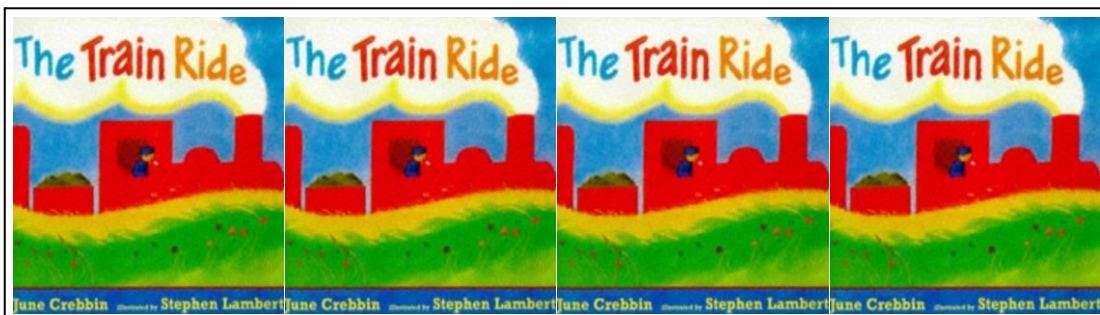
In maths, we are focusing on applying our knowledge of counting on, counting back, doubles, halves and sharing by solving problems.

Have a go at writing the following dictated sentence:

The crowd on the train groans as the train gets stuck on the track.

Remember to use cursive letters and sit your letters neatly on the line.
