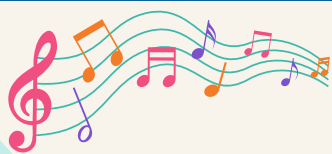
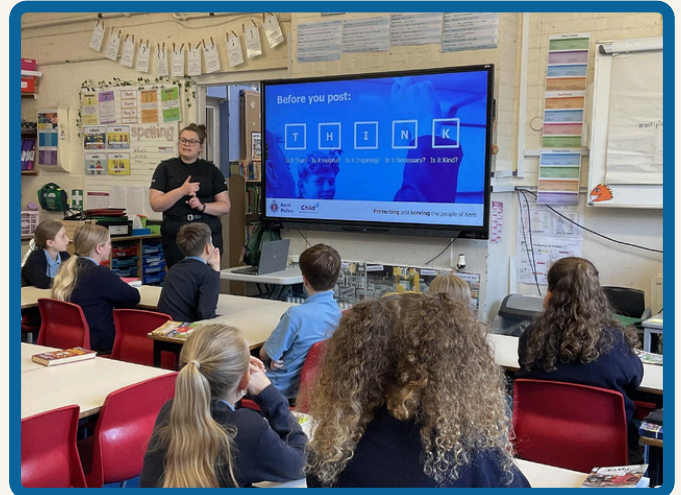
## SWORDFISH CLASS WORSHIP
