In Phonics, we will be reading and writing words reviewing all our learning:

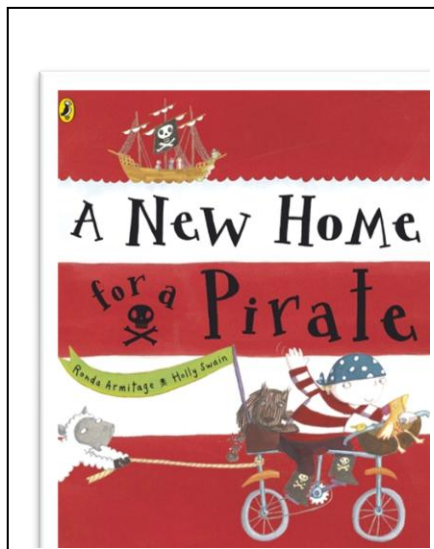

What we are learning:

This week we will be sharing a favourite story as we start a pirate themed 2 weeks: 'A new home for a pirate.' We will be predicting what pirate paraphernalia might be used for and looking in depth at the characters feelings and wishes. We will be comparing the similarities and differences between a pirate school and our school and writing instructions to find hidden treasure.

In maths, we will be developing our ability to explain how we work something out using vocabulary such as "is equal to." We will be making repeating patterns using shapes and colours.
