

# Safeguarding - Lanyard System



For a **blue lanyard** the person must:

Have a verified DBS.

OR

Work for an approved organisation, have a prior appointment to be in school and be able to present their work badge.

*NHS - SALT - Social Worker - CAFCASS - St Helens Council*

**This person is safe to work with children.**



Please provide a **green lanyard** if they:

Are in school to work with or speak to children (must be able to present a work ID or badge).

Do not have a verified DBS.

Are meeting a staff member during school hours.

Are a parent moving through school (e.g. an arranged meeting)

**This person is a visitor and must be accompanied at all times.**



Please provide a **red lanyard** if they:

Do not have a verified DBS.

Cannot provide a work ID or badge.

Are not in school to work with children.

Are contracted to work on the school premises for maintenance reasons.

**This person may move freely around school to carry out their appointed work.**

**They must not communicate with children while on the school premises.**
