Safeguarding - Lanyard System



For a blue lanyard the person must:

Have a verified DBS.

OR

Work for an approved organisation, have a prior appointment to be in school and be able to present their work badge.

This person is safe to work with children.



Please provide a green lanyard if they:

Are in school to work with or speak to children (must be able to present a work ID or badge).

Do not have a verified DBS.

Are meeting a staff member during school hours.

Are a parent moving through school (e.g. an arranged meeting)

This person is a visitor and must be accompanied at all times.



Please provide a red lanyard if they:

Do not have a verified DBS.

Cannot provide a work ID or badge.

Are not in school to work with children.

Are contracted to work on the school premises for maintenance reasons.

This person may move freely around school to carry out their appointed work.

They must not communicate with children while on the school premises.
