

This week in Reception

Phonics:

In Phonics this week we will be revisiting all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs - ai, oa ee, igh, ur, or, er, ar, ow, oi, ear, air. We will be reading words containing 2 or more digraphs - sharp, harsh, shark, march, sheep, cheep, queen, chain chart, tooth, singer, thinker, powder, corner, farmer, shorter, shower, power.

We will be reading and writing sentences such as : The singer has a helmet with a torch.

Tricky words - his, her, of, as, we, me, be, she, he, they, was, you, all, pure, sure, my, by, are.

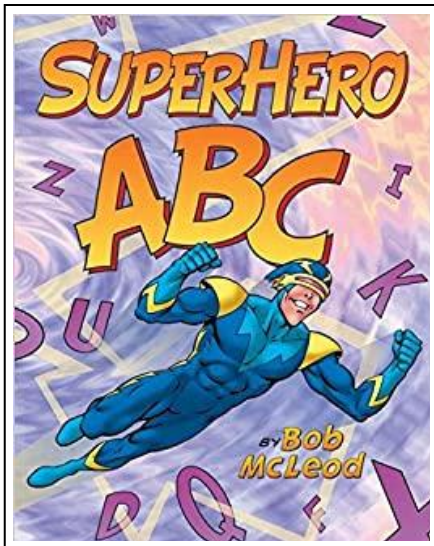
Week beginning 9.3.26

What we are learning:

In Protective Behaviours we will be continuing to talk about our own early warning signs when we don't feel safe and who we could tell identifying a network hand of adults.

In Literacy, we will be sharing 'The Superhero ABC' and using alliteration to make up our own superhero names. We will talking about and writing about the skills and attributes their chosen superhero shows.

In maths, we will be practising counting backwards and learning to count back from a number to solve problems of subtraction such as 10 count back 3 leaves 7. We will be jumping backwards on number lines physically as well as using our fingers on smaller ones.



At home

Practise counting ins 2s and 10s.

Play I count, you count. You say 1, 2, 3 and then point to your child to continue the counting eg 4, 5, 6, 7. Keep changing who you are pointing to, yourself or your child to carry on the counting sequence. Look at house numbers and numbers around the environment and try and spot any odds and evens.

Have a go at reading words with double letters in the middle:

Shimmer buzzer mutter better supper butter

Can you write 'We feed all the rabbits supper.'

And finally: Enjoy sharing your decodable book 3 times a week and please write a brief comment in the reading diary.
