Dear Parents and Carers,

Seasonal Flu vaccination programme for students in Year 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11

As part of the national vaccination programme, we have been asked to share the attached information from the NHS Trust with you.

You will shortly be contacted directly from the NHS Trust Immunisation team with information on how to give or refuse consent for your child to be vaccinated. Please ensure that you complete the consent form by **Friday 5th December 2025** to make sure your child does not miss out.

If you do not provide consent then please be aware that although the NHS Trust may ask your child to self-consent if they are in Year 8 or above, due to the logistics of planning this session, and the level of uptake, we cannot guarantee that they will be given this opportunity. Therefore, if you wish your child to receive this vaccination, it is important that you submit your consent decision via the link sent to you by the NHS Trust Immunisation Team.

The planned date for this vaccination is **Wednesday 10th December 2025**.

Whether you give consent or do not wish your child to receive this vaccination, we ask that you share this information with your child so that they are prepared on the relevant date. If your child is absent on the day of immunisation or fails to attend, we are unfortunately unable to offer an alternative opportunity, as the Immunisation Team has no plans to return to the school to provide this vaccination.

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The school aged immunisation service is changing the way we ask for vaccination consents

Dear parents /carers

The school-aged immunisation service, or SAIS team, has been working with NHS England to improve how vaccinations are recorded and managed in schools, to ensure vaccination data for children and young people is accurate and timely. This will also help to reduce vaccination errors and protect children and young people and improve the online consent experience for parents and carers.

Consequently, NHS England have developed a new digital platform called MAVIS: Managing Vaccinations In School. This is a new national system which will be rolled out nationally over the next few months. Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust's (LPT) SAIS team has been one of two organisations to successfully pilot this new system, nationally.

What changes to expect from the new platform

The SAIS team will now contact you directly to request consent for vaccinations, instead of information being sent via your school. This new approach will make it quicker and easier for you to give or refuse consent for vaccinations. If consent is not received the service will allow the children or young person to self-consent if aged over 13 years and competent.

The SAIS team will request a class list from your child's school containing your child's name, date of birth, and contact information, such as phone numbers and emails addresses for parents/carers of young people who are eligible for the vaccinations. The SAIS team will then use these contact details to send consent requests and reminders directly to parents/carers.
