
Familiar faces to support the learning journey.

Phonics teaching is such a vital building block for learning and we're here to help you achieve amazing results at every crucial stage.



The lesson plans use our 4 part teaching method...




Daily sounds and words to be taught, are clearly shown, and build sequentially across the week. It's so straightforward!

On a Friday, Reading and Writing printable Minibooks will be uploaded to work on with your child at home. These wonderful and creative resources allow your child to apply their learning from the week, as they read and write their own book.
