




Dear Parents & Carers,


Astronomy night delayed. Thanks to all the families who signed up for astronomy night, due to the weather forecast we have had to postpone this event.






More information to follow. Due to the event depending on good weather, we are hoping for it to be between 23rd January to 3rd February but will confirm the day before.







