Activity	Key Questions
Planting flower seeds. (science enrichment)	Knowledge- How can we care for a plant to enable it to grow? Is this the same for all plants? (link to KS1 Science) Analysis- Which conditions are best for growth? How do you know this? Evaluation- What would you do differently next time and why?
Seasonal Tart using root vegetables (DT Enrichment)	Do you think all vegetables and fruit are grown locally? Which other countries provide us with food? How does it get here? Why do we have to buy food from different countries? Do you know which vegetables and fruits belong to which food groups?
African Drumming (Music Enrichment/geography)	What is the purpose of drumming in different African cultures? What role does rhythm play in African music compared to melody or harmony? How do different drums create different sounds?
Cinema (Social and emotional PSHE)	Who was your favourite characters in the film and why? What genre was the film? What did you learn from the film?
Cycle track (PE, Science)	What parts of the body do we need to use? What happens to your heart when you cycle fast verses when you cycle slowly? Which muscles do you use most when riding a bike?
