Y6 SATS

Next week the children in Y6 will sit their SATS. I asked Mrs Walls to write what the SATS are which is included below. We also submit children’s writing levels based on teacher assessment according to very strict criteria. The Local Authority hold the responsibility to moderate that the submitted assessment levels are correct.

Why SATs?

In England, SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) are national tests taken by children at the end of Year 6 (Key Stage 2) to measure their progress and attainment in English and Maths

When are the tests?

The statutory KS2 SATs will take place on the following dates:

- **Monday 11 May 2026** – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (Papers 1 & 2)
- **Tuesday 12 May 2026** – Reading
- **Wednesday 13 May 2026** – Maths: Arithmetic (Paper 1) and Reasoning (Paper 2)
- **Thursday 14 May 2026** – Maths: Reasoning (Paper 3)
