



Key Vocabulary

Key Word	Definition
Generate	To bring into existence.
Decorative	Anything used to make something more attractive or festive.
Aesthetic	Concerned with beauty or the appreciation of beauty.
Tessellation	When a flat surface, like a floor or a piece of paper, is covered with repeating geometric shapes.
Negative Shapes	The space that surrounds a particular figure or object.
Positive shapes	The area that is the focus or subject of the artwork.
Repeating pattern	A series that is repeated more than one time.
Juxtaposition	Putting two, or more, contrasting things next to each other so that you really see their differences.
Sensory	Any activity that stimulates our senses - touch, sight, hearing, smell and taste.
Articulate	To make things, such as shapes or objects, clear to see.
