Where can I find lesson materials?

What does homework look like?

The specifics of your homework tasks will depend on the requirements of the lesson, and the information will be detailed in the task on ClassCharts. This could involve watching information videos, listening to revision podcasts, consolidating knowledge with questions amongst other activities.

What does Guided Learning look like?

You have **Guided Learning booklets** that are specific to each topic you are studying. These contain exam questions which are related to the content you have been covering in class. You are expected to complete the exam questions and then use the mark schemes to check your answers, marking in a different coloured pen! These will be checked regularly for completion.
