After filling our tummies, we played fun games outside in the fresh air. We ran, laughed, and enjoyed spending time with our pirate crew — our friends!

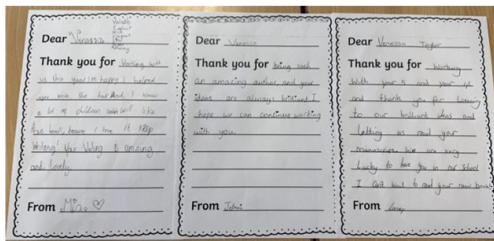
It was a jolly good day full of treasure (our sandwiches!), teamwork, and smiles. Ahoy, what fun we had!

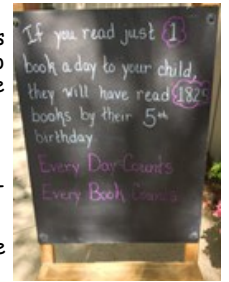
Year 2 Signing Assembly
