Dear Families,

It was great to see you at our 'Book Look'. I know the children had fun talking to you about their learning this term.

It has been another busy and exciting week in year 3.

In English, we made Japanese fruit skewers, by following our own recipes to make them. The children really enjoyed choosing different fruits, including mangoes, pears and strawberries to add onto their skewers before finally eating them!

In maths, we are learning to add 1s across a 10. In Kirfs, we have now finished our number bonds to 100 and will move on to counting in multiples of 50 and 100 after half term.

In RE, we discussed the bible story 'Sermon on the Mount, Matthew 6:25-34. In 'Open Book' assembly today, some of the children took part performing the bible story 'The Prodigal Son' in front of the whole school.

In Science, we continued to learn about how the muscles work by making moving arms, representing the biceps and triceps, using cards, split pins and elastic bands. We discussed how the muscles contract and relax when they move.

In history we learnt about Stonehenge, children were able to make models in class using play dough, lego and wooden blocks. They also learnt about the different types of stones found at the site, where they could have come from and how they could have been transported nearly 200km from Wales to Salibury.
