<p>By the end of Year 4, all children should know all multiplication facts up to 12x12. This is an opportunity for Year 5 children to rehearse and apply these essential facts.</p> <p>They should be able to answer the questions in any order, including missing number questions.</p> <p>They should be able to apply these facts to multiplying multiples of 10, 100, 1000 and decimal numbers.</p> <p>Eg <math>700 \times 60</math>    <math>0.03 \times 7</math>    <math>7 \times \underline{ } = 28</math>    <math>\underline{ } \div 6 = 7</math></p>	<p>What is 8 <b>multiplied by</b> 4?</p> <p>What is 6 <b>squared</b>?</p> <p>What is 108 <b>divided by</b> 12?</p> <p>What is the <b>product of</b> 11 and 12?</p> <p>What is 1.2 <b>multiplied by</b> 6?</p> <p>What is 7 <b>times</b> 0.8?</p> <p>What is 8.4 <b>divided by</b> 7?</p>
