| Reincarnation | The rebirth of a soul in another body. |
| Mahatma Gandhi | Indian lawyer who employed nonviolent resistance to lead a successful campaign for Indian independence. |
| Resurrection | Resurrection is the concept of coming back to life. |
| Zakat | Annual payment made under Islamic law used for charitable or religious purposes. |
| Hajj | Muslim pilgrimage to Mecca |
| Pilgrimage | A journey made to a sacred place as an act of religious devotion. |

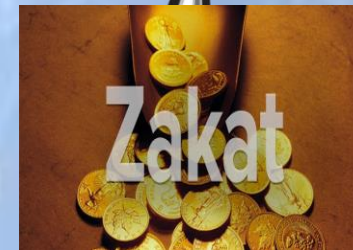
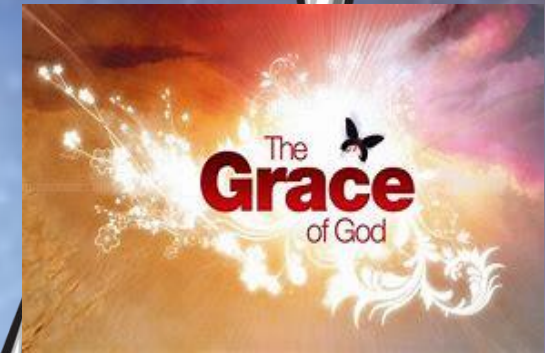
Ahimsa is about respecting all living things, and the avoidance of violence towards others for our Hindu, and Buddhist friends.
