Rationale	As a result of the national lockdown many of our children missed out on key learning across the second half of spring term and first half of the summer term 2020. A smaller number also missed out on learning during the second half of the summer term. Many of our pupils were able to engage with home learning provided at this time, but this is no substitute for attending face to face learning on site and with their teacher. To support a smooth transition back into school in September all children returned to their previous class teacher who knew them and their learning well. This period of transition provided opportunities for teachers to assess children and identify gaps in pupils' learning at an individual and group level. As the term progressed and our summative and observational evidence was collated and analysed, we were then able to sharpen our additional intervention support and focus this on identified gaps in pupil's learning and well-being. We also considered the stage of school the groups or individuals had reached, this served to inform the 'urgency' of additional input.

Well –being intervention	PATHS (promoting alternative thinking strategies) is the programme we use at Falconbrook that underpins our teaching of emotional literacy, resilience, self-regulation and emotional articulacy. To support all children on their return we utilised the PATHS Recovery Programme to facilitate pupils' discussion and exploration of their experiences during the lockdown. Regular 'keeping in touch' phone calls made by teachers to children and parents during lockdown and after (this is ongoing). Families who had experienced crisis /difficulties during (& after) lockdown have been referred for support to the Falconbrook Help Hub. 30 families have been referred to the Wandsworth Foodbank (4.12.20) 1:1 therapy in place for identified children (& their families where appropriate) 1:1 Mentor support in place for identified children 1:1 attendance & welfare officer (AWO) support for families concerned about child attending school during pandemic (September and during 2 nd lockdown)
