Year 4	Areas of Study-
Listening	<p>Listen and show understanding of short phrases through physical response</p> <p>Listen and demonstrate understanding of words in songs and rhymes</p>
Speaking	<p>Ask and answer several simple and familiar questions with a rehearsed response</p> <p>Use familiar vocabulary to say simple sentences to give information using a language scaffold</p> <p>Join in with the words of a rhymes, song or story sometimes from memory</p>
Reading	<p>Read aloud familiar short sentences using knowledge of letter string sounds and observing silent letter rules</p> <p>Read and show understanding of simple familiar phrases and short sentences</p>
Writing	<p>Write and say a simple phrase to describe people, places, things and actions using a language scaffold</p> <p>Write simple familiar short phrases from memory with understandable accuracy</p>
Language Learning Strategies	<p>Use a bi-lingual dictionary to find the meaning of a word or its translation</p> <p>Use the correct form of the indefinite article in the singular, according to the gender of the noun, and in the plural</p> <p>Demonstrate understanding of the position of the majority of adjectives</p>
The Francophone World and Intercultural Understanding	<p>Respect and understand cultural diversity.</p> <p>Appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language</p>
