Key Word	Definition
Iron Age	When weapons and tools came to be made of iron.
Empire	A group of countries ruled over by a single leader or Emperor
Celts	A name for the people living in Britain during the Iron Age - also called Britons
Invasion	When one country enters another country by force and takes control
Resources	A supply of valuable materials such as metals or slaves
Settlement	People living together in one place.
Artefact	Anything made by people in the past. Archaeologists use these to find out about how people lived.
Romans	People who came from the Empire of ancient Rome.
Rome	The capital of the Roman Empire. Today the capital of modern Italy
Paganism	Religions where people believed in many different gods
