


Plants – Identifying and Growing




Geography

Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.



History

Changes within living memory. Where appropriate, these should be used to reveal aspects of change in national life.



PE

Term 1

Dance – Movement takes dance. 6 weeks of fun dance lessons working on transitions and following choreography whilst linked to the book of the term.

Term 2

Striking and Fielding – children will develop skills on how to hold the bat and strike correctly. They will look at spatial awareness to eliminate the opposition.



DT

Make – can colour fabrics using paints to print and paint.

Make – can join fabrics using staples and a running stitch.

Make – can decorate textiles using buttons, beads, sequins, braids and ribbons.

- Make a model using natural and man made materials to show a simple idea or using imagination.
- Describe difference and similarities between sculptures by well-known artists

Health and Wellbeing

Children will gain understanding of the importance of a healthy lifestyle and what a healthy lifestyle looks like by:

- Describing how to keep fit and healthy and understand basic dental hygiene.
- Sharing personal successes with his/her class.
- Using vocabulary to describe when they feel good and bad and discuss simple ways to manage those feelings.
- Understanding how to keep themselves clean.
- Describing simple ways to stay safe in different environments.
- Understanding the difference between a secret and a surprise.
- Understanding who they can seek help from if they are worried.
