<p>Personal Social and Emotional Development</p> <p>Heart Smart</p>	<p>In Heart Smart this half term the children will be learning about how others help us as well as being able to show care and affection to others in appropriate ways.</p>	<p>Communication and Language</p> <p>Literacy</p> <p>RWI -phonics</p>	<p>In Literacy this term our focus story is 'Let's all creep through crocodile creek' by Jonny Lambert</p> <p>The pupils are continuing on their phonics journey through RWI.</p>	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>Music</p> <p>DT</p>	<p>In Music this term pupils will be learning to sing in pitch and feeling the lilt of a 2-3 pattern of beats in music.</p> <p>In DT this term pupils will be learning how to thread and weave.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p> <p>PE</p>	<p>In PE this half term the children will learn about dance and how to explore different movements and shapes. We will be making sequences that correlate with the music.</p>	<p>Maths</p>	<p>In Maths this term pupils will learn composition of 5, the meaning of zero, and develop secure knowledge of numbers to 8. Pupils will also learn about mass and capacity.</p>	<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>Science</p> <p>RE</p>	<p>In Science this term pupils will be identifying the changes that happen during winter. Identifying different habitats and describing some of their features. Investigating floating and sinking.</p> <p>In RE this term pupils will be learning about why the word God is so important to Christians.</p>
