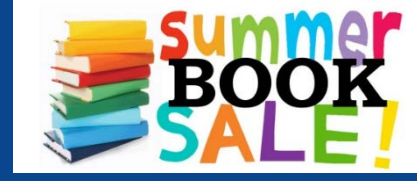

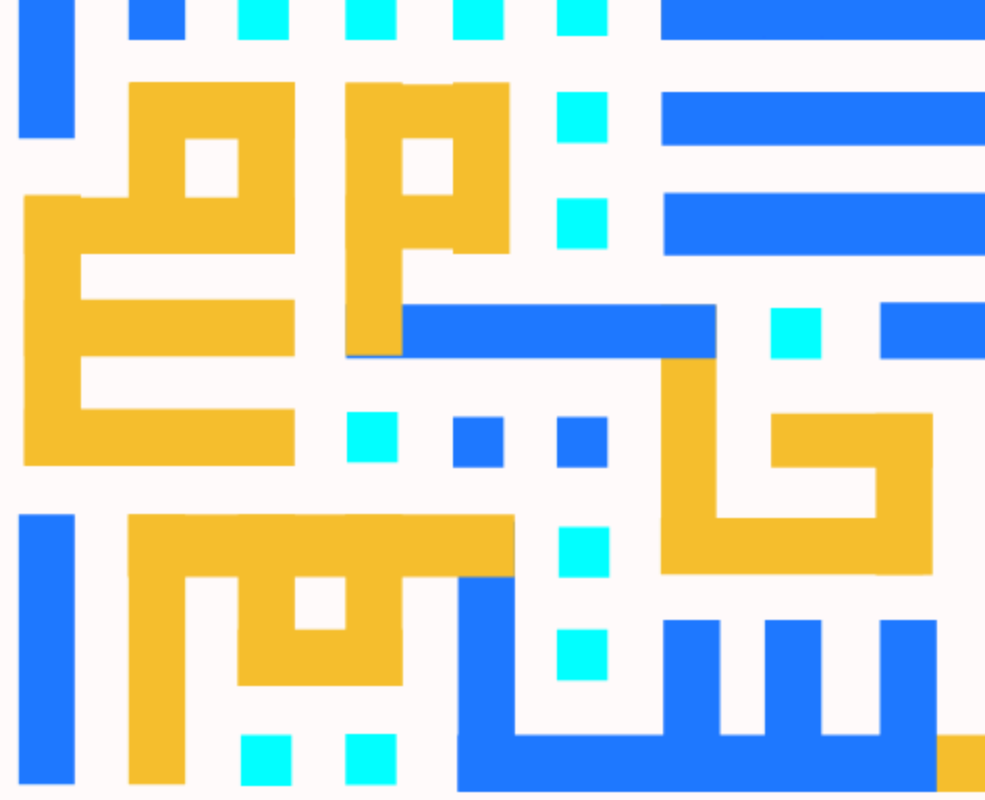
MAZE MAKER

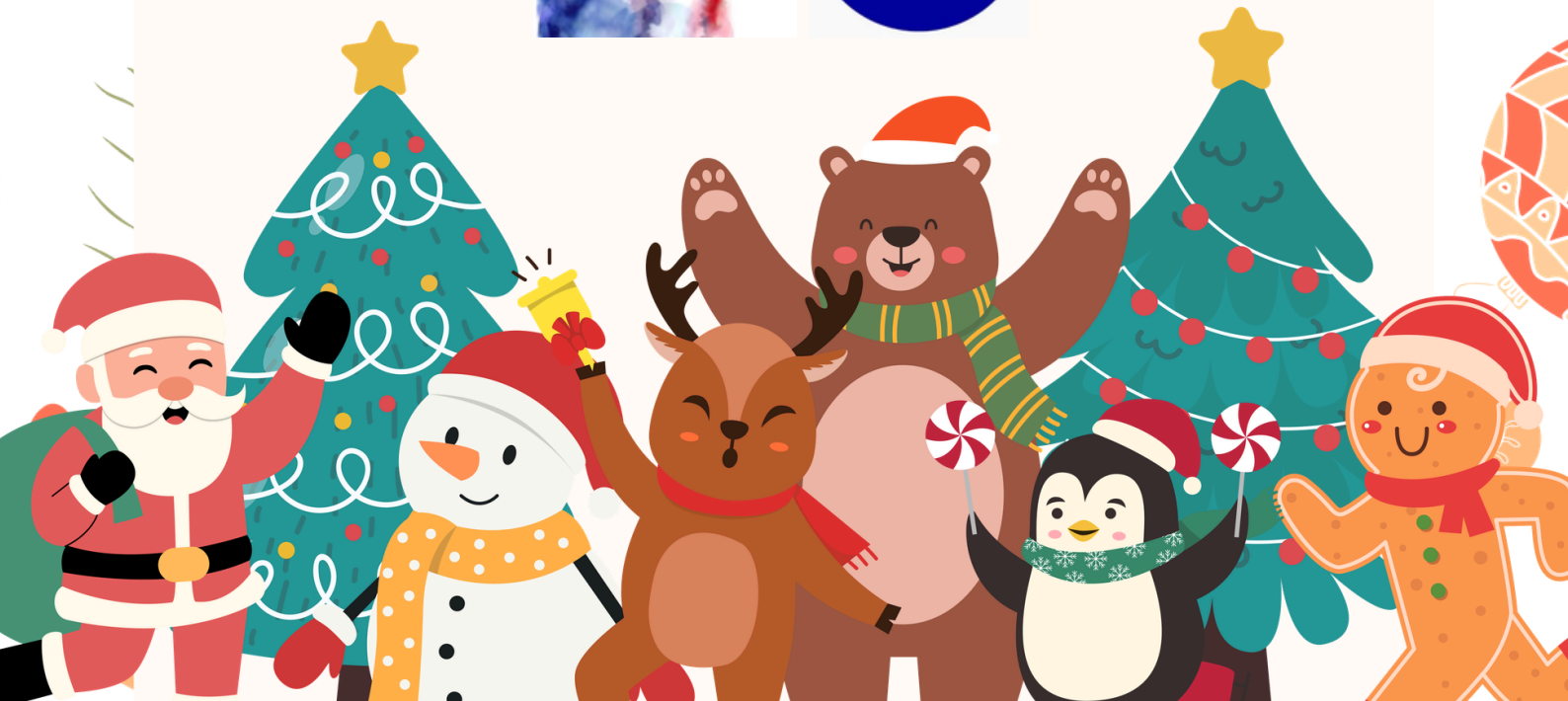
RAF NORTHOLT
