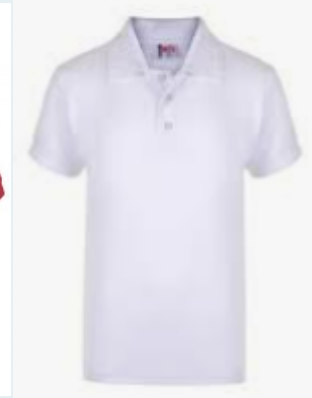

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# Nursery Sessions

**Morning Sessions;** 8.45am—11.45am

**Afternoon Sessions;** 12.15pm—3.15pm

The children will have access to a range of activities throughout the sessions.

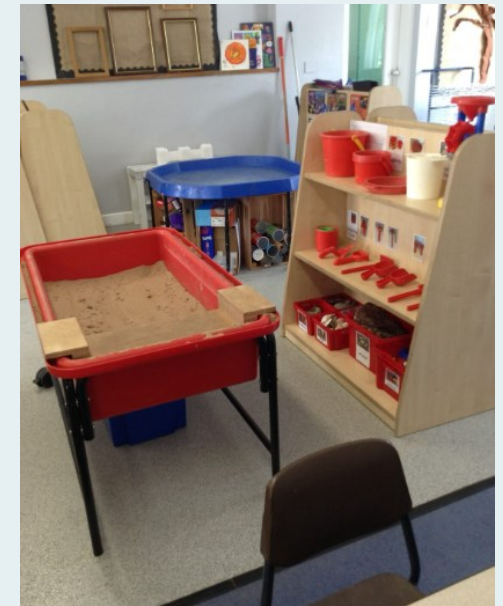
These will include independent activities or group adult-led activities.

The children have access to the activities in the classroom and the outside area.

Snack time is a set supervised time in both sessions. The children choose if they have a snack and help themselves. They sit at the table and have access to their water bottles or a cup of milk.

**Lunchtime;** 11.45am-12.15pm—which is charged via parent pay

The children eat in the hall with the rest of the school. They are supervised by a member of the nursery team and other support staff.

- Jacket potato served with - beans, cheese, tuna
