I can spell all of the Year 3/4 word list.


Superstar Spellers

I can structure my writing appropriately (e.g. headings, sub-headings in non-narratives, settings, characters and plot in narratives).

I can use good examples of writing to help me plan my own writing.

I can choose nouns or pronouns appropriately for clarity and cohesion and to avoid repetition.

I can use and punctuate direct speech, including punctuation within and surrounding the inverted commas.

I can show possession for singular and plural nouns correctly.

I can use expanded noun phrases, including with prepositions.

I can write in Standard English for verb inflections: I did vs I done.

I can use fronted adverbials and commas after them where necessary.

I can use a wide range of conjunctions.
