

To know the 24 clock and analogue conversion

Key Facts	Key Vocabulary
<p>Children need to read, write and convert time between analogue and digital, 12 hour and 24 hour clocks. There are 2 ways of telling the time:</p> <p>The 12 hour clock splits the day into:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the 12 hours running from midnight to noon/midday (the am hours) and the 12 hours running from noon/midday to midnight (the pm hours) <p>The 24 hour clock shows how many hours and minutes have passed since midnight (midnight is 00:00)</p>	<p>hour, minute, second o'clock half past quarter past, quarter to twelve hour clock twenty four hour clock digital, analogue, am, pm</p> 

Top Tips

*Children could create their own timetable to record key events of the day, eg wake up, go to school, morning break, lunch, home-time, clubs, dinner, bedtime... what time do these events happen? Use the 12 and 24 hour clock to record the times

*Tell your child how long TV programmes are and ask them to work out when they will finish on the 12 and 24 hour clock

*Ask what the time will be in 5 minute, 10 minutes, quarter of an hour, 1 hour etc on the 12 hour and 24 hour clock
