

## This week in Reception

### Phonics:

We will segment the sounds in words and write words such as rain, moan, sheep, night, turn, born and digger. We will continue to read and write words ending in '-ing' such as swimming, bumping, snapping, squelching; words ending in 'ed' such as stamped, bumped, helped, smashed and blinked; and words ending in 'est' such as plumpest, strongest and swiftest. We will use these words in our sentence writing eg He bumped his leg when he was swimming, she stamped her foot on the chair. We will revisit all phase 4 'tricky' words (see below).

### What we are learning:

In Literacy, we are sharing John Burningham's *The Shopping Basket* and using talk to discuss the different ways the character of Steven tricked the animals. We will be writing simple sentences from the story working on segmenting sounds and using a capital letter at the start of a sentence and a full stop at the end.

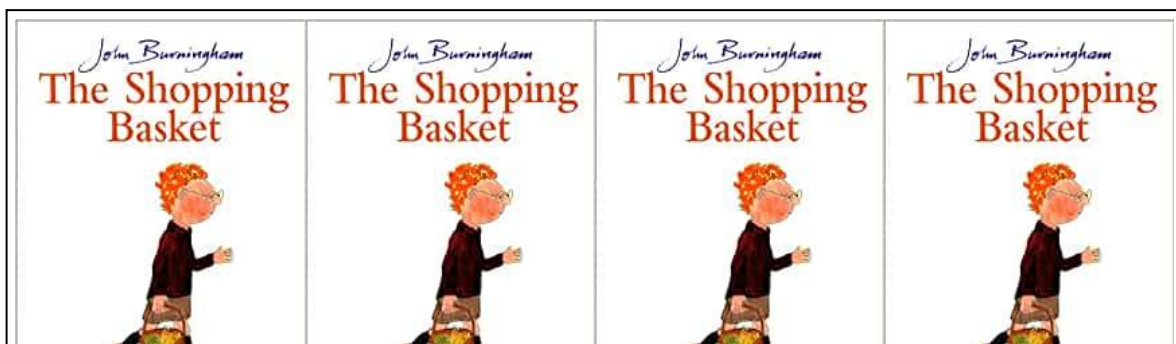
We will be sharing what we have learnt through the topic of food by using talk and then making posters about food. The children will present their poster and knowledge to their classmates.
