School Choir. Thank you to all who joined the school choir, there are over 65 participants and they are learning songs to perform at Christmas.







School Attendance. As you know we have a duty to report our pupil attendance rates to parents. We will now include an attendance traffic light on each newsletter to communicate our current whole school attendance figure and the target we are aiming for. Thank you for everything you do as parents to ensure your children attend school punctually and regularly, it is very much appreciated, particularly as we are still living within a pandemic situation.

The information below shows that whole school attendance for the dates between 6th September and 11th November 2021 is currently **92.7%**, which is below the expected attendance rate of **96% or higher**.
