### **Prayer and Reflection**

This weekend (on Sunday 29th June) we celebrate the Feast of St. Peter & St. Paul, the Apostles. The day commemorates the martyrdom of two saints, the two great Apostles, Saint Peter and St. Paul, assigned by tradition to the same day of June in the year 67 AD. This is probably one of the oldest feast days celebrated in the Christian calendar.

Peter was the leader of the apostles and the first pope. Paul was born Saul, but converted to Christianity on the road to Damascus. They had been imprisoned in Rome and both had foreseen their approaching death. It is said that they were martyred at the command of Emperor Nero. Let us pray:

O holy Apostles, Peter and Paul, I choose you this day and forever to be my special patrons and advocates; Saint Peter, Prince of the Apostles, because you are the Rock, upon which Almighty God has built His Church; you, Saint Paul, because you were fore-chosen by God as Preacher of truth in the whole world. Obtain for me, I pray you, lively faith, firm hope, patience in adversity, humility in prosperity, attention in prayer, purity of heart, a right intention in all my works, diligence in fulfilling the duties of my state of life, constancy in my resolutions, resignation to the will of God and perseverance in the grace of God; that so, by means of your intercession and your glorious merits, I may be able to overcome the temptations of the world, and may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.
