If you are predicted a good pass or better in GCSE Mathematics, and are intending to take A levels or other level 3 courses with mathematical content (e.g. Psychology, Geography, Biology), our **Core Maths Skills** course will help you to consolidate GCSE Mathematics techniques in contexts that support effective transition to your new studies.

The Core Maths Skills course will cover the following areas of maths from GCSE:

- Measures and standard form
- Percentages
- Data tables, averages and spread
- Estimation and accuracy
- Interpreting graphs and charts (statistics for life)
- Probability
- Ratio and proportional reasoning

The QR code takes you to the integral website where you can set up a free account and practice these skills. Each section contains a variety of online questions and printable worksheets to help you to build and revise these skills. We will be testing these skills again in the first few weeks of the new term so please go through each section as needed. When you are ready take the progress check for each unit, your progress will be saved on the site and will have the option to print a certificate.
