

### Reception Spring i

To say 1 more than a given number up to 10

by the end of this half term, children should be able to say one more than any given number up to 10.

1 more than...	They might be able to record it as a calculation:
1 is 2	$0+1=1$
2 is 3	$1+1=2$
3 is 4	$2+1=3$
4 is 5	$3+1=4$
5 is 6	$4+1=5$
6 is 7	$5+1=6$
7 is 8	$6+1=7$
8 is 9	$7+1=8$
9 is 10	$8+1=9$
10 is 11	$9+1=10$
	$10+1=11$
