This week in Phonics we will be assessing the letter - sounds taught so far and asking the children to blend sounds together to read words such as hug, peck. Please keep practising blending sounds together to read CVC words.

What we are learning:

Our learning this week is based around the festival of Diwali and the story and traditions around this festival of light. We will be sharing the story of Rama and Sita and answering comprehension questions. Then, we will be retelling the story, taking on the roles of the different characters behind masks. In addition, we will be designing our own rangoli patterns using symmetry.

In maths, we will be focusing on the numbers 4 and 5. We will be looking at different combinations of 5 and questioning whether different groups of objects have more or fewer. We will be looking at the same and different and contemplating what 4 looks like and what doesn't constitute 4. We will be starting to explore that the concept that parts of a number together make a whole.
