

The school day

- · Doors open at 8.45am and close at 8.55am; this allows for a calmer start to the school day.
- All Teachers welcome children at the gate to pass on any messages, if you require a longer chat please make an appointment at the office.
- The children will have access to a range of activities throughout the day. They will cover all areas of the EYFS curriculum. This will include independent activities for the children to access and adult-led activities from the teacher or teaching assistants.
- We follow the RWI phonics programme, more information is available on our website, plus a parent workshop in the Autumn term.
- The children will always have access to the activities in the classroom as well as the outside area, whatever the weather.
- Snack time is on a free flow basis, children choose whether they would like a snack and help themselves. They sit at the tables and have access to their water bottles or a cup of milk. Staff supervise and encourage as much independence as possible.
- School ends at 3.15pm; your child will be released to you from their designated gate. Pupils will be released as teachers see you, please stand back from the gate to ensure we can see all parents.

Woodland Adventures

We have weekly opportunities to spend time in our woodland area. This is where we encourage the development of your child's emotional and physical development through outdoor play, activities and exploration in a natural environment.

September-Staggered Start

- Monday 1st Teacher Training Day
- · Tuesday 2nd September Teacher Training day and Phone call from class teacher to part of Squirrels class
- Wednesday 3rd / Thursday 4th September Phone call from your Class Teacher; to answer any of your questions, have a chat about your child.
 - Some visits for part of Squirrels class.
- Friday 5th September 15 minute visit; for you and your child to have a look at their new classrooms and outdoor area.
- · Monday 8th Children who currently attend our Nursery will start school full time.
- · Tuesday 9th Children who have received this date will be in school today
 - Not on Wednesday 10th.
 - Your child will be in school full time from Thursday 11th
- Wednesday 10th- Children who have received this date will start school full time.

Once your child is in school

- It's normal for them to be tired during the first weeks of school.
- · Sometimes they can be a bit vague on what they have been up to!
- · If you have any concerns please speak to us
- Check their book bag, school webpages, WEDUC the school app and Parent Pay
- · Celebrate their achievements.
- Remember every child's learning journey is different.
