Introduction

Durham Trinity School and Sports College is committed to ensuring there is an opportunity for a range of education, care and training providers to access pupils, for the purpose of informing them about a range of qualifications, care and learning pathways available to them post school including apprenticeships and technical education, where appropriate.

Durham Trinity School and Sports College is fully aware of the responsibility to set pupils on the path that will secure the best possible outcome, which will enable them to progress in education, on a personal level and/or in the World of Work.

The policy statement complies with the Durham Trinity School and Sports College's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997 and within The Department of Education, July 2021: "Baker Clause": supporting students to understand the full range of education and training options, and the Provider Access Legislation, January 2023.

Pupil Entitlement

All pupils are entitled:

To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of the careers programme, which provides information on the full range of education, care and training options available at each transition point. This information will help pupils to make informed choices and thus reduced the chance of a pupil becoming NEET (not in education, employment or training).

- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer including those providing technical education and apprenticeships through options events, assemblies, careers workshops or conventions and taster events.
- To understand how to make applications for technical courses and apprenticeships.
