

How is RE delivered at Post-16?

Our Post 16 provision provides a safe space for young people to develop their understanding of people, cultures, faiths and relationships. It also helps pupils to develop their own understanding of the world and how to live, in the light of their learning, developing understanding, skills and attitudes.

It is delivered through:

Assemblies

Students have regular assemblies which cover religious, ethical and philosophical topics such as: Black History Month, Holocaust Memorial Day and Human Rights Day and Religious Festivals.

Tutorials

Students complete a weekly current events news quiz and a philosophical discussion in their tutor groups. In addition, as part of the tutorial programme Tutors deliver activities related to PSHE or RE.

Life Skills lessons

A short Scheme of Learning covers an examination of a variety of world views and religions in relation to a range of ethical issues and is delivered through the life skills lessons.

Enrichment

Students will participate in a half-day ethics conference focussed on a moral dilemma looking at different faith perspectives and world views on the issue. Delivered on an enrichment day. Students have the option of participating in Enrichment activities such as the amnesty international club and debate club.
