### Phonics:

In Phonics, we will be reading and writing words ending in '-ing' such as groaning, creeping, sleeping and painting. We will be reading and writing words ending in '-ed' (b) such as cloaked, sparked screeched. We will be reading and writing words ending in '-ed' (id) such as crowed, boasted. We will say the following sentence 3 times, and count the words. We will segment the sounds in the words and write the sentence using cursive letter formation: 'I am painting the moon.' We will continue spelling 'tricky' words.

### What we are learning:

In Literacy this week, we are sharing the very thought-provoking story of 'Somebody swallowed Stanley'. This is a wonderful story of the journey of a plastic bag travelling through the ocean. Hopefully, it will prompt us to all start thinking more carefully about plastic pollution in the ocean.


In maths, we will be focusing on solving problems using a range of resources such as number tracks, a tens frame, numicon, counters and small world animals.
