### **Fox Class activities**

In **Maths** we have now completed our multiplication and division unit for the 2's, 4's and 8's.

In **English** we were writing formal letters to Mrs Lawlor. Children have started to use persuasive words in their writing, for example, 'furthermore' to add additional information.

In **Science**, we made a zigzag book about how fossils are formed.

In **RE**, we were learning about Judaism in particularly 'The Book of Covenants' and the 10 commandments.

In **Art**, we drew and painted pictures inspired by the American artist Georgia O'Keeffe using watercolour paints.





In **History** we were learning about the different types of homes in the Bronze and Iron Ages and answering the question 'Was life better in the Bronze Age or the Iron Age?'

In **PE** children will be continuing **swimming lessons** after half term up until the end of the spring term. They are enjoying practising this very important lifelong skill and really look forward to going on Friday afternoons. Thank you to all our volunteer parents for supporting us escorting the children to and back from swimming each week.
