As in previous years, each department will have both a morning and an afternoon performance, except for the nursery department, which will only perform once, as two performances would be too demanding for them

Families will be given the option of buying up to 2 tickets per pupil in the concert (ie either 2 for the am, OR 2 for the pm, OR 1 for both).

The remainder of tickets going on sale on a first come first served basis. More details regarding this will be published later today.

In each concert, for years 1-6, the youngest year group will form the choir and the oldest year group will perform on stage. This is repeated every year, ensuring that everyone has had opportunity to be in both the choir and on stage within the last 2 concerts. Information regarding costumes and ticket box office days will be sent home in due course.

School Attendance

The table below identifies three sets of statistics relating to school our whole school attendance. The 'Weekly Attendance' figure shows the attendance for that week. The 'Running Attendance' shows the school's attendance percentage from September to date and for this term to date.

If the percentages are coloured red, they are below our whole school target of 93%. If they are coloured in green, they are equal to or above our 93% attendance target for the whole school.

Thank you to everyone for your efforts in keeping attendance strong this term. Here's how we're doina:

- Starting Strong: In the first two weeks of September, attendance was above 93%, which is a great start!
- A Dip in Week 3: We saw a noticeable drop to 89.7% in Autumn Week 3. Illness and seasonal bugs often play a part here, so let's keep promoting healthy habits.
- Steady Recovery: Since then, we've been climbing back up! By Week 10, attendance is back to 92.1%, showing fantastic improvement.
- Overall Picture: Our running attendance since September is 92%, we're moving in the right direction.













What's Next?

Every day in school counts! Let's aim to push our weekly attendance above **93%** as we head towards the festive season. A big thank you to families for working with us, your support makes all the difference.
