Comprehension- Word meaning	* checking that the book makes sense to them, discussing their understanding and exploring the meaning of words in context
Comprehension- Understanding	*asking questions to improve their understanding *summarising the main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph, identifying key details to support the main ideas
Comprehension - Inference	*drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence
Comprehension- Prediction	*predicting what might happen from details stated and implied
Comprehension- Authorial Intent	*identifying how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning *discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader

Comprehension - Non-fiction	*distinguish between statements of fact and opinion *retrieve, record and present information from non-fiction
Comprehension- Discussing reading	*recommending books that they have read to their peers, giving reasons for their choices *participate in discussions about books, building on their own and others' ideas and challenging views courteously *explain and discuss their understanding of what they have read, including through formal presentations and debates, *provide reasoned justifications for their views
