I am often asked about how Belvoirdale Primary School keeps children safe and the answer is very simple; I follow the laws, rules and requirements that every school is instructed to follow, including health and safety, fire and emergency, safeguarding and evacuation. These areas also include lockdown and terrorist threats. Every school is required by law to have policies in place, in case of emergency and they are reviewed annually. Each year the Belvoirdale Governing Body carry out a safeguarding audit and every two years Leicestershire Education Authority do the same. We have safety and fire inspections each year as well as a health , buildings and maintenance check each year.

We are a nut free school because we have pupils and teachers who have severe



allergies to nuts. The phrase "may contain nuts" that is often found on food labels is acceptable to bring into school.
