



Rainbow Fish Class Newsletter Term 1




This term we will be reading the stories Elmer, Peace at Last and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We will be listening carefully to stories and learning why listening is important.

We will also be learning some new vocabulary and talking about these stories with our friends.







Our Jigsaw learning will be about helping others to feel welcome and caring about other people's feelings. In Rainbow Fish Class, we will be learning how to work well together and we will create our own class learning charter.

In Rainbow Fish Class, we use Supersonic Phonic Friends to learn our phonics. This term, we will be beginning to learn the sounds in Basics 2 and we will be blending the sounds to read words.

This term, we will be exploring signs of autumn and we will go on an autumn walk along the canal path.





Developing a strong grounding in number is essential so that all children develop the necessary building foundations to excel mathematically.

In mathematics this term, we will be exploring repeating patterns in a range of contexts such as shapes, colours, sizes, actions and sounds. Rainbow Fish Class will have a wide range of opportunities to develop their knowledge of the counting sequence, including through rhyme and song. This term, we will also be exploring the composition of numbers to 4, as well as subitising amounts within 3.



In RE, Rainbow Fish Class will be exploring why the word 'God' so important to Christians. We will be exploring the Bible and we will also be reading the Christian story of 'Creation'.
