
A Level Physics

Where can I find lesson materials?

Powerpoints for each lesson will soon be loaded onto **Teams** and **Sharepoint**

You should take good care of your lesson notes as these provide you with all the essentials that you need to know.

The **full specification** will be loaded to the Teams area, and sharepoint so you can check your notes to ensure that they are complete.

For each area of the specification, you should have your own notes (from class). At the start of each topic the relevant section of the specification is printed for you.

What does homework look like?

Homework this year is in the form of **exam-style questions** or on Isaac Physics questions. Homework is set on **Classcharts**.

When you receive **feedback** in class, you will have the **opportunity to add detail**, and look at **example answers**, to help you to improve your **exam technique**.

What does Guided Learning look like?

You have **Guided Learning Orange workbooks** that focus on each area of the specification. The tasks in the booklets help to consolidate and test the material we have learnt about in class. This is to help you to start the process of **revision** from the beginning of the year, and to help you to find **revision methods** and **recall techniques** that work for you. You should use the revision guide to help you complete the work book.

What you have revised in Guided Learning will then be applied in your exam questions for homework.
