

Wynstream Handwriting Approach

Parent Information

At Wynstream Primary School, we teach handwriting regularly to help children develop clear, fluent and confident writing.

We follow the **RWInc Handwriting progression** from EYFS – Year 2. These sessions **take place daily** and focus on:

- **Correct posture and position**
Ensuring children sit comfortably and hold their writing books and pens correctly.
- **Effective pen or pencil grip**
Supporting children in developing a stable, efficient grip for smoother writing.
- **Correct letter formation**
Providing structured, step-by-step handwriting instruction to help children achieve fluency and automaticity in forming letters.

We follow the **Teach Handwriting** scheme across Years 3–6. Handwriting sessions take place **three times per week** and focus on:

- **Correct posture and position**
Ensuring children sit comfortably and hold their writing books and pens correctly.
- **Effective pen or pencil grip**
Supporting children in developing a stable, efficient grip for smoother writing.
- **Careful cursive joins**
Teaching joined handwriting step-by-step so children develop a fluent, legible style.

Our aim is to build children's confidence and pride in their written presentation, helping them apply neat, joined handwriting across all subjects.
