Are we born with a conscience?



Our *Life Skills* learning for this half term are all about being healthy and this week in my assemblies, I challenged the children to think about their conscience. Are we born with a fully formed Moral Compass or does our environment and social interactions influence and shape our reactions and our character? I am privileged to work with amazing children and families and usually our conversations return to the same subjects, behaviour, truth and respect. Part of growing up and becoming a happy and healthy citizen of any community, (home, school, Coalville, the world), is to develop a healthy conscience, that allows us to make smart choices, even if that means sometimes admitting that we are wrong. This is often called the **Fight & Flight** mode. The Trauma Responses are the initial incidents that trigger the reaction, and my staff and I encounter all of these responses many times, from many different individuals, every day; not always from children. Understanding that everyone has different responses, makes us better individuals, teachers, parents, human beings and allows us to make reasonable adjustments to support each other in our day to day lives.
