The Roman Empire

The Roman Empire was the largest empire of the ancient world. Its capital was Rome. The Roman Empire had a powerful army and was ruled by a powerful man called an Emperor.

The Roman Army invaded Britain in AD 43. When they controlled England and Wales they built roads to move around quickly. They also built towns and cities like Aquae Sulis and Londinium.

The Roman Army fought the PICTS but they couldn't defeat them, so they built a wall. This wall was called Hadrian's Wall.
